## THE WORLD'S BIGGEST BABY SHOWER AND BABY BOTTLE BOOMERANG

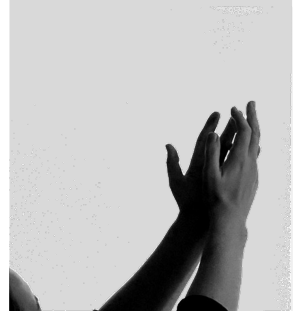
