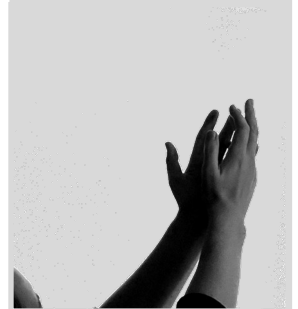
ALTAR GUILD—WOULD YOU LIKE TO JOIN?
